Start/End Time: August 2,2020, 10:00 AM PST through August 9th, 2020, 10:00 AM PST Distance: 131 miles per team

Eligibility: All team members and individual participants must be a registered Relay For Life of Humboldt County participant. Participants can be located anywhere in the US. There is no limit to how many members a team can have.

Activities Allowed: Running, Walking, Hiking, Treadmills - anything on your feet!
