Bicycle helmets required for all participants during bike ride. No electric bikes. Wear appropriate clothing, bring layers, it often is cool; no public nudity. Lifeguards on deck. Swim flotation devices allowed for kids. Parents may assist their child during any portion of the race. Kids swim age groups start separately. Race course well-marked and supervised. Custom swag. Race chip timed by e8TIMING.
